- ❑ Student voice is about the opinions, views, experiences and feelings of individual and groups of students
- ❑ It describes how students give their input into what happens in their classroom and their school

- ❑ Students have untapped knowledge that needs to be heard

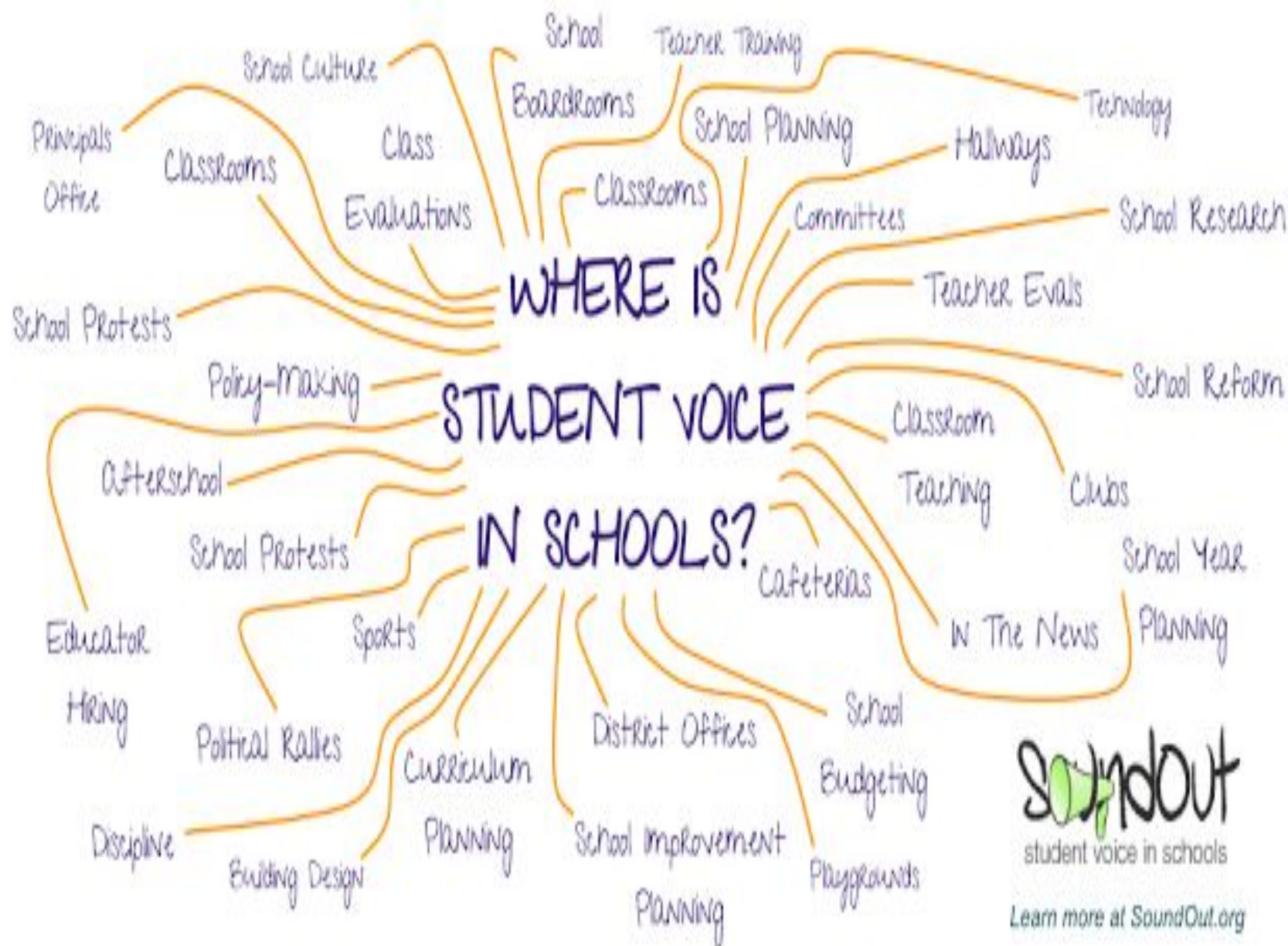


How do we Facilitate the Student Voice?

- Surveys

- Active listening
- Recording and reviewing student feedback
